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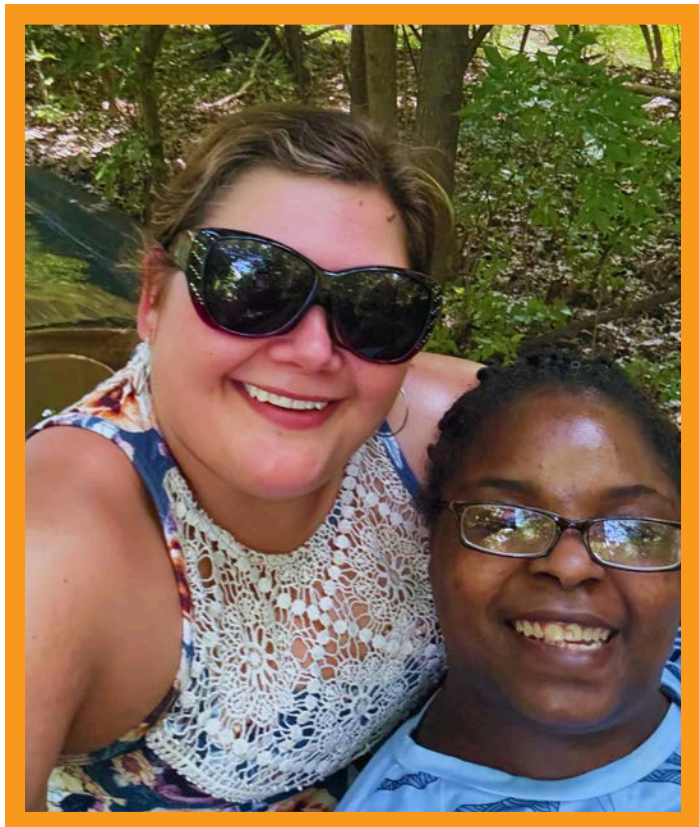
ABOUT US

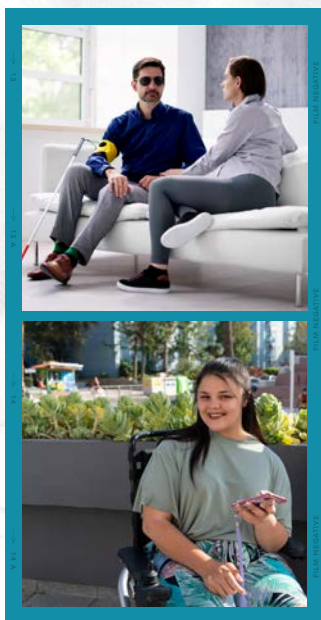
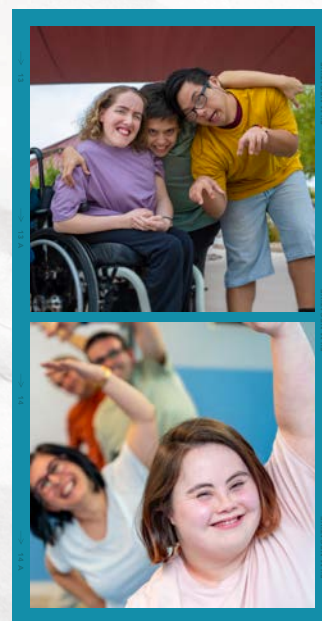


AUTISM AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

OUR AUTISM AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDE COMPASSIONATE, EVIDENCE-BASED CARE FOR INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES ACROSS CENTRAL INDIANA. OUR TEAM OFFERS DIAGNOSTIC TESTING, APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS (ABA) THERAPY, AND INDIVIDUALIZED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SUPPORTS DESIGNED TO BUILD COMMUNICATION, SOCIAL SKILLS, INDEPENDENCE, AND CONFIDENCE. WITH A PERSON-CENTERED APPROACH, WE MEET INDIVIDUALS WHERE THEY ARE AND PARTNER WITH FAMILIES TO SUPPORT MEANINGFUL PROGRESS AND LONG-TERM WELL-BEING.

COMMUNITY LIVING AND RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

LIFE COACHING

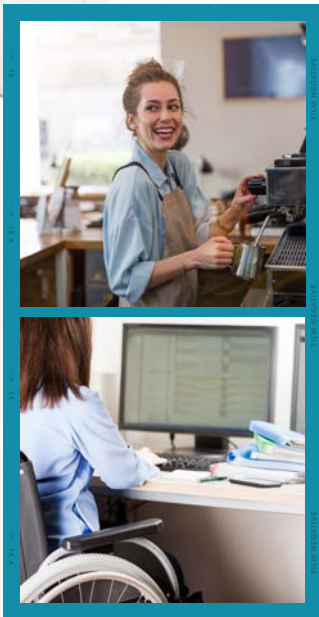

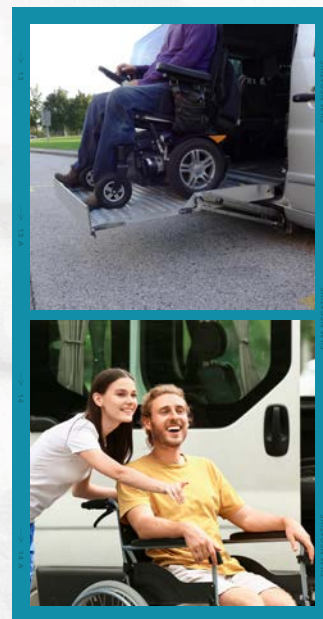
EMPLOYMENT CONSULTING AND EXTENDED SERVICES

WELLNESS SERVICES

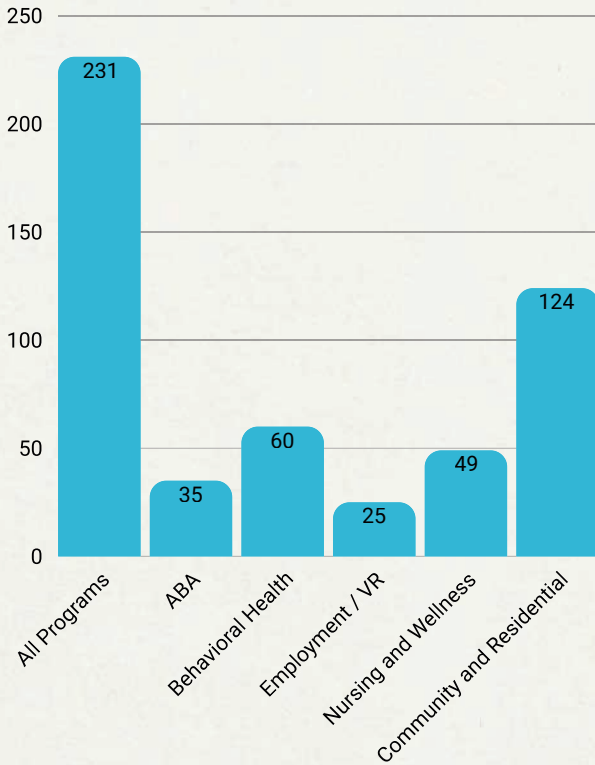

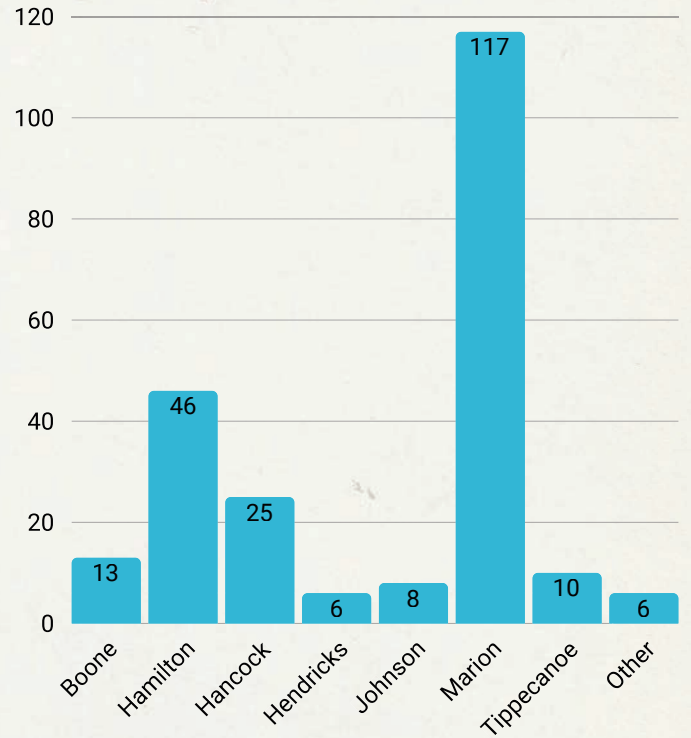

Clients Served By Program

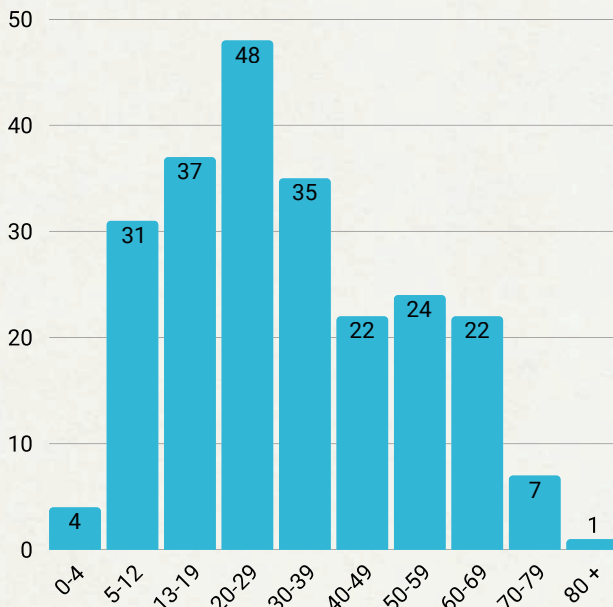


Clients Served By County

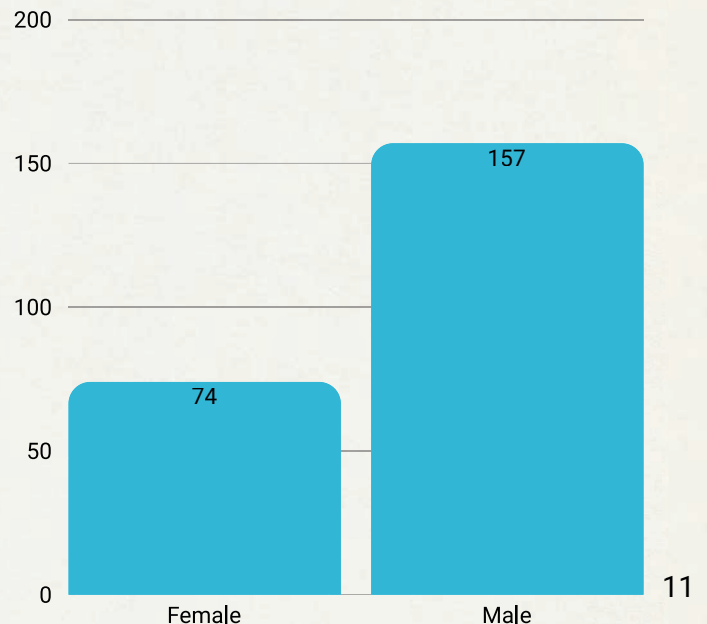

Clients Served By Age



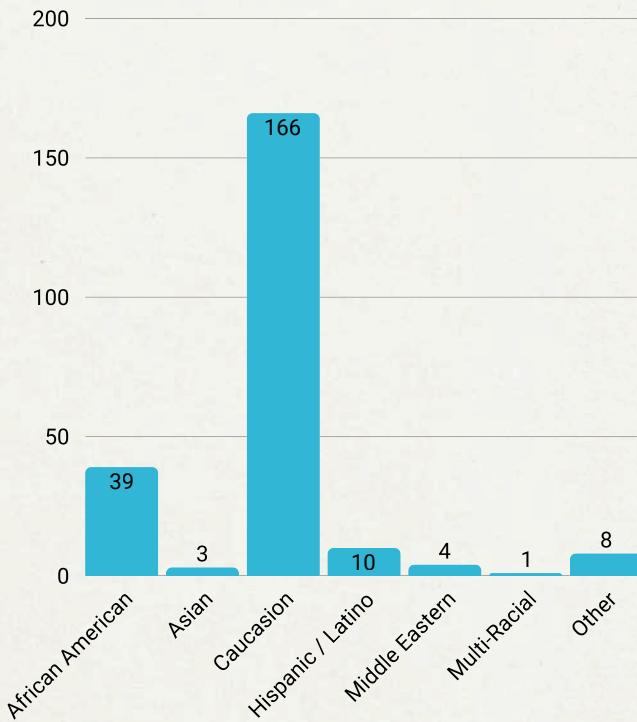
Clients Served By Gender



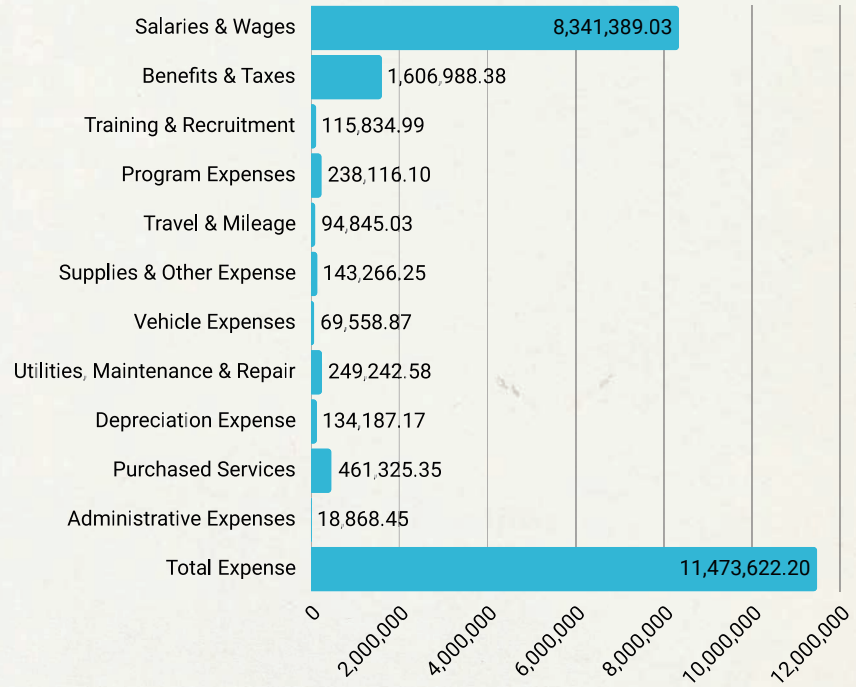


CLIENT DEMOGRAPHICS & REVENUE SOURCES

Expense Breakdown By Type



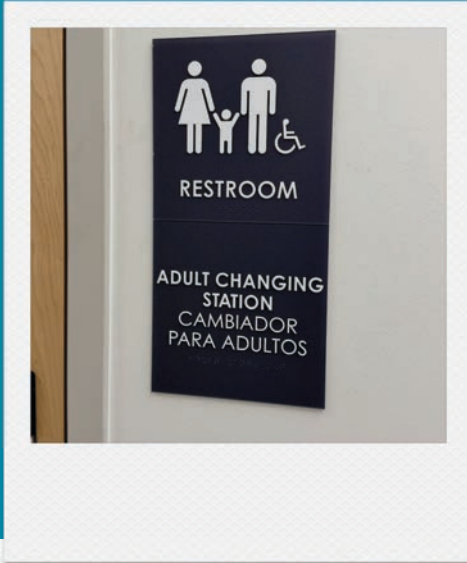
Revenue Breakdown By Type

Moments of connection, stories of impact...

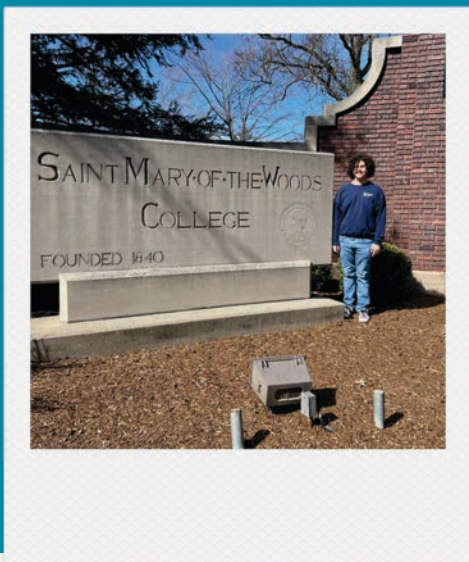


This year, Tangram partnered with the Indianapolis Public Library to expand access to Adult and Universal Changing Stations across Marion County. These full-size, accessible changing tables provide individuals with mobility needs a safe and dignified option while out in the community.

New stations are now available at the Nora and Pike branches, with the Central Library location coming soon. This partnership reflects Tangram's commitment to advancing accessibility, dignity, and belonging—helping ensure everyone can fully participate in community life.

This fall, Russell and Josh took a trip to Brown County State Park with their staff, where they enjoyed a picnic lunch and explored the park while taking in the fall scenery. The outing was part of building new seasonal traditions and encouraging community exploration across Indiana.

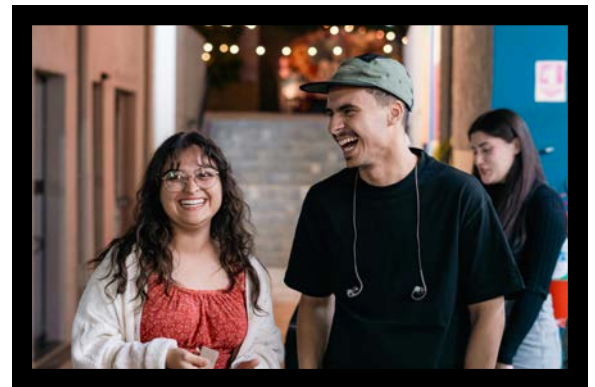


Early Explorers Prep
